


Saurignon Blanc

Centa Vineyard Saint Helena, Napa Valley

Made with 100% Sauvignon Blanc harvested from Centa Vineyard, one of our two Estate vineyards in Saint Helena. The fruit comes from vines grown near the banks of the Napa River, where relatively cool summer temperatures help retain a balance of flavor and acidity. We age our Sauvignon Blanc almost entirely in Stainless steel except for the hard press juice which goes into a neutral French oak barrel. By doing so we can soften some of the harsher acids and phenolics while adding a touch of texture, mouthfeel and complexity to the body.

Gibbs Sauvignon Blanc is light bodied with crisp acidity and an elegantly long finish. The nose is generous, exhibiting aromas of tropical fruits, lemon peel, pear and subtle white florals that compliment a light, but immensely flavorful body bursting with mouthwatering Meyer lemon, tart Granny Smith apple, and juicy pineapple. The finish is quite lengthy, showing more tropical flavors of passion fruit and lychee.

### Winemakers Notes:

Gibbs Napa Valley Chardonnay dances a fine line between richness and restraint. Fermented in French oak and stirred on the lees for the first 16 weeks, the mouthfeel is round and lush up front with vibrant flavors showing on the mid palate and extending through the finish. A truly beautiful balance between classic Napa Valley opulence and modern winemaking clarity.

Delicate florals, a touch of toasted oak and hints of lemon zest on the nose. The body offers classic Napa depth, showing deliciously juicy pear, melon, stone fruits and just a touch of brioche that are complimented by fresh acidity on the mid-palate and finish.

COROTTO VINEYARD LOS CARNEROS, NAPA VALLEY

The 2021 vintage marks the third year that we've worked with beautiful Chardonnay grapes from the Corotto Vineyard in Carneros, and we couldn't be more excited! Like our Bacigalupi Vineyard Chardonnay, this wine is part of our "selection" series. These wines are made in small batches from single vineyard sources.

The Corotto Vineyard is a beautiful property composed of six blocks in the Southern reach of the Napa Valley; Los Carneros. The Chardonnay we source comes from two of these blocks planted in the late 1990's. We barrel ferment and age this wine in French oak for 8 months; stirring on the lees for the first sixteen weeks to add texture and body. Perfumed florals, toasted oak and subtle citrus aromatics complement flavors of green apple, tropical pineapple, custard and notes of beeswax with a mineral, silky texture that coats and lingers on the palate.

Pinot. Noir

Los Carneros Napa Valley

### Winemakers Notes:

We source our Pinot Noir from one of the cooler growing regions in the Napa Valley, Los Carneros. Situated close to the San Pablo bay, this area is characterized by ample fog and regular cool breezes, making it perfect for cooler climate varietals such as Pinot Noir.

Aged in a combination of 50% new French and Hungarian oak, Gibbs Pinot Noir has a unique and complex structure with deep, spicy notes. Rich in color with a mediumplus body, the aroma and palate are of luscious strawberry, ripe cherry and rhubarb.

Our "selection" series consists of wines that are small production, sub-appellated bottlings made only when Craig feels he has some truly special fruit to work with. Wines that hold this title are rarely made in subsequent vintages and sometimes will only be made once from a particular vineyard.

Dusty Red


Dusty Red Blend Napa Valley

Craig puts this blend together with the goal to create a wine that is incredibly food friendly and has a whole lot to offer right out of the gate. Each varietal is fermented individually and blended prior to bottling.

The 2021 Dusty Red is comprised of Petit Verdot, Merlot, Malbec, Cabernet Sauvignon and a touch of Cabernet Franc; a classic Bordeaux blend flipped on its head. Petit Verdot accounts for over half of this blend, providing a powerful core of black fruits and structure. Malbec brings more dark fruit and tannin while Merlot offers juicy red fruits and a velvety mid-palate. Cabernet Sauvignon adds depth of flavor and earthy notes while Cabernet Franc lends intriguing herbal undertones to the overall blend. This is our homage to the weeknight Napa Valley reds of yesteryear.


## Winemakers Notes:

Our "Napa styled" Cabernet Franc offers all the classic notes of old-world Cabernet Franc in a bolder and more boisterous fashion than one might find in Bordeaux or the Loire Valley. Ripeness is the name of the game here as we let this fruit hang late into the growing season to ensure it develops rich depth of flavor beyond the harsh and unpalatable stemmy green notes often found in young, under-ripe Cabernet Franc.

The 2021 vintage is beautifully complex, layered, and rich with character only made more powerful thanks to the addition of Petit Verdot. Violets, blue fruits, and herbal notes on the nose seamlessly meld with a body showing blueberry, dark boysenberry, bitter chocolate, and a touch of green bell pepper. The tannins are fine, but ever present bringing beautiful structure to this layered and age worthy wine.

Our flagship Cabernet owes its name to the three Cabernet clones grown on our two Estate Vineyards; 6, 15, and 337, that create the core of this delicious wine. Each clone adds unique character, complexity, and depth to the Cabernet Sauvignon. We craft our Three Clones Cabernet with the end goal of presenting a wine that is incredibly balanced; showing well in it's youth, but with the ability to age beautifully for years to come. On the nose there are aromas of ripe black cherries, baking spice, dried herbs and dusty French oak with a textured midpalate bursting with black plum, juicy dark fruits, and notes of black pepper. Finely etched tannins are present throughout providing structure and extending the delicious finish that hints at notes of coffee and dark chocolate.

### Winemakers Notes:

The 2020 Oakville Cabernet comes from a highly sought after vineyard in the heart of the valley. In fact, this vineyard is so sought after that this is the first and possibly last time we will get a chance to work with the fruit so we jumped at the opportunity. We blended some of this wine into our Napa Valley Cabernet Franc, but chose to set aside 6 barrels that were in a league of their own! Spending an additional 6 months in French oak allowed the wine to develop into a bigger, more complex and concentrated version of our Napa Valley offering.

Aromas of red current, black tea, graphite, violet and red cherry leap from the glass, complimented by subtle vanilla and spice notes imparted by French oak. The body is plush and velvety, showing ripe blueberry and dark cherry framed by dried herbs, sage and earthy undertones.



### Winemakers Notes:

The 2019 Calistoga Petit Verdot is one of the biggest and boldest wines we've ever made! You'll find a splash of Petit Verdot in many of our Gibbs reds, but it wasn't until the 2018 vintage that we chose to bottle a small allotment of single varietal Petit Verdot. It was a huge hit, so we are back with another select bottling from a beautiful vineyard in Calistoga.

A deep and dark violet hue in the glass, this wine is all about power, structure and length. Blackberry jam, cracked walnut, graphite and subtle aromas of eucalyptus give way to a decadent body showing juicy dark fruits, cocoa, currant, and hints of black licorice.

# Winemakers Notes:

This wine is a very special one-off bottling of Oakville Cabernet Sauvignon! We had the chance to work with this incredible fruit in 2020 at a ridiculous price and we jumped at the opportunity. We may never see this fruit again and it is sure to fly out the door so grab it while you can! A nose of blackberry, cassis, and chocolate with hints of vanilla gives way to a deep palate of dark cherry, ripe plum, and mocha wrapped around grippy, yet plush, tannins. The vintage of 2020 lent winemakers supremely ripe fruit, the outcome of which is shown in the deep redish purple hue of our staple Cabernet Sauvignon.

Craig Handly started making wine and bottling it under his first label, Terroir Napa Valley, back in 2001; long before he took over the Estate Vineyards in St. Helena and started Gibbs Vineyards with his son Spencer Gibbs Handly.
